Nominations should include a brief biography and discussion of the significant involvement and contributions towards conservation of fisheries and/or aquatic resources. The only criteria for this award is that the award is based on fisheries and/or aquatic resource-related work accomplished in Arizona or New Mexico and can span more than one year.
